

## Sumio Mabuchi

Minister of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism

Mr. Sumio Mabuchi began his career as an engineer in the civil engineering technical consulting department of a general contractor company after he graduated from the Department of Civil Engineering, Faculty of Engineering, Yokohama National University.



After completing two more careers, he was appointed to a board of directors in 1993, becoming the youngest board member of any listed company in Japan. Furthermore, he managed a North American subsidiary of the company as Chief Executive Officer. He also undertook urban development projects as a manager of redevelopment projects for factory sites.

He was first elected to the House of Representatives in November 2003, and is now serving his third term. In September 2010, he was appointed as Minister of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism.
